EEA March Education Series Webinar

Benedikt Bünz, co-founder of Findora, provided an overview of the basic cryptography needed to build and operate a blockchain. Despite common misconceptions, blockchains only require fairly lightweight and established cryptographic tools – namely, a digital signature scheme and a secure cryptographic hash function. He addressed how these work and the most common algorithms used out in the field. He also explored how more powerful cryptographic tools, like zero-knowledge proof, can make blockchains more private and scalable at the same time.
