Download Key Ecosystem Results – Ethereum Mainnet Use Case Analysis v1

The EEA Enterprise Use Cases and Requirements Task Force (TF) conducted a 21-question survey to help identify enterprise use cases and applications for Ethereum Mainnet. We are excited to make this analysis available to the EEA community in a series of reports focused on the current state of the Ethereum ecosystem and utilization of the Ethereum public blockchain (Mainnet).

Formed by members of the EEA Mainnet Working Group in early 2020, the task force is identifying the use cases and requirements needed for use in the design and build of technical solutions to meet the needs of customers globally.

The EEA community has long sought accurate market analysis, and these series of reports will effectively provide the ecosystem with invaluable insights. We would like to give a special thanks to Daniel Norkin at [Envision Blockchain](#) and Tas Dienes at the [Ethereum Foundation](#) who played a key role in spearheading this analysis for the betterment of the greater community. Noteworthy Technical Updates

Highlights from our Technical Working Groups include:

- The Cross-chain Interoperability Task Force will soon publish its Use Cases document, which describes common reasons for performing operations across blockchains and the requirements that affect the mechanisms we develop
- All the technical groups have been working over the last month on a 2021 roadmap
- A specification and implementation of cross-chain computing in early 2021
- Re-factoring of the Offchain/Trusted Compute specification to clarify implementation needs this year
- More Trusted Computing options, such as using ZKP and enabling Federated Trusted Execution Environments
- Examples and deployments of Baseline, and outreach work from the Mainnet Working Group
- A new Byzantine Fault Tolerant consensus algorithm, expected to happen this year or early 2021

The technical work proceeds most effectively when there are a diverse set of stakeholders providing feedback. So, whether you represent a blockchain client developer, a customer wanting a client to run in a consortium, or a software integrator providing tailored solutions or other tools, your input can influence the work and ensure that it meets our goal of solving real problems for real enterprises, large and small. 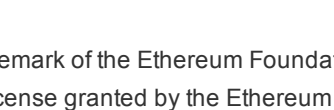
