The formation of EEA Community Projects signals to the world that there is now a central location where Ethereum-related business standards are developed and new projects are advanced.

## Technical Working Group Updates

The EEA chartered two groups this month:

- **The Trusted Execution Working Group** has rechartered, with a stronger focus on delivering tutorial and explanatory information, as well as maintaining the specification and providing more detail for other methods to support secure computing.
- The brand new **Authority-to-Operate Working Group** aims to define the requirements to produce an EVM (Ethereum Virtual Machine)-based blockchain that closely mimics other Enterprise Ethereum networks, and can achieve NIST's "Authority to Operate."

**The Mainnet Interest Group** is holding "office hours" to provide EEA members and followers an opportunity to talk to top industry IT experts that can answer your questions and help you determine the right approach and solutions to use for the job at hand.

**The Financial Services Interest Group** continues to explore topics relevant to the use of Ethereum blockchains in supporting the needs of the financial industry and its customers.

**The Supply Chain Interest Group** is meeting in a slightly revised format to further their ability to provide helpful information and motivate useful discussions on topics relevant to the world of supply chains.

**The Core Specs Group** is closing in on a model for Byzantine Fault Tolerant Consensus, while the **Cross-Chain Interoperability Working Group** is working on deployment options.

**The Tokenization Group** held its first meeting, essentially setting the scope for the group.

**The Eth 2 for Enterprise Group** held its second meeting, where ConsenSys' Ben Edgington explained the current roadmap for Ethereum evolution with nary a "2.0" in sight.

**The Interoperability Testing Working Group** has been taking a break, and working on building a framework to support better test automation.

**The EthTrust Security levels Working Group** has been grappling with the hard, detailed, work that is central to its charter, testing all and everybody around.

Good standards are developed through collaboration between competitive implementers and their customers to ensure that we are solving real problems. 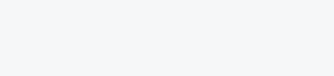

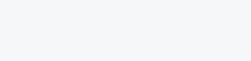
