


Ethereum in the Enterprise 2022 Recap




Palm NFT Studio Joins the EEA at the Board Level

Interest Group & Working Group Updates

Once again it has been a busy month for many of our groups including exciting face-to-face opportunities for many.

Technical Working Group Updates

Our newest group, the **Ethereum Training Quality Working Group**, has been making progress on its initial deliverables, agreeing on a path forward, and working to enable people to participate from whichever time zone they find themselves in – an important consideration for a global organization like EEA.

The **Core Specifications Working Group** is preparing its QBFT specification for publication. This has been a multi-year effort, going back to discussions in 2018 about consensus mechanisms for version 2 of the Enterprise Ethereum Client Specification; and they are now working on version 7 of the specification. The group has also been working on the Enterprise Ethereum Permissioned Blockchains Specification with security enhancements.

The **Authority to Operate Working Group** has not met recently but is developing a streamlined process aimed at getting work done faster, particularly in between meetings.

The **EthTrust Security Levels Working Group** is making progress on their specification, with hopes to publish version 1 soon. The specification is being boosted by detailed reviews coming in along with new participants. The latest **Working Group drafts** are publically available for those interested to see how the work is progressing.

The **Crosschain Interoperability Working Group** has been making progress. In many cases, their deliverables are at a more mature stage, and they have recently been working with the EEA Community Project on Layer 2 standards to show how their deliverables can actually solve the problems that the group has just started to discuss as priority issues.

Interest Group Updates

The **Tokenization Interest Group** welcomes **Benjamin Bukari** of Abbacio as the new co-chair to join **Daniel Norkin** of Envision. The group is mapping out their work over the next few months, including plans for webinars and how to ensure that the material is easier to find.

The **DeFi Interest Group** has had a few changes. The Group is saddened to see co-chair John Ho step down, after a long history of contribution to the group and to the Financial Services Interest Group he co-chaired before that. We are grateful to ongoing co-chair Niko Casagrande, an individual member of EEA, but we are looking forward to a new co-chair helping to ensure the group continues to provide a forum for discussion of issues around Decentralized Finance.


