





## Interest Group & Working Group Updates

Another busy month for many of our groups, check out their updates below!

### Technical Working Group Updates

• The **Authority to Operate Working Group** has been exploring different scenarios to achieve "authority to operate" according to NIST standards. They will now look for member input on which scenarios are important to justify further technical development and which use cases will direct the next phase of their work.

• Are your contracts secure? Says who? The **EthTrust Security Levels Working Group** is nearly finished with its current specification. This includes wrapping up the numerous reviews they have received from different security auditors, a thorough editorial clean-up, and finishing work on the last few outstanding issues.

This is an important new EEA technical specification, outlining requirements for security audits of smart contracts. With the increasing value of the Ethereum mainnet, and the increasing role of Solidity/EVM smart contracts in many blockchains, this topic is even more relevant. This specification is intended to address that gap in the ecosystem. When the first version is published, the Working Group plans to collect feedback and study how it is used, to continue making updates when appropriate. Stay tuned for more.

• The **Testnet Working Group** (formally known as the Client Interoperability Testing WG) has been making progress on documenting the setup for EEA members to work on an EEA testnet. The group plans to publish a test generation framework to enable rapid testing for different EVM versions (or "hard forks" or "network upgrades") that will help improve the ability to test EVMs for use on all Ethereum networks.

• The **Core Specifications Working Group** is preparing the new QBFT Consensus Algorithm specification for publication and deciding on further work and focus. The EEA's work has diversified substantially to meet the broader needs of a growing ecosystem, rather than focusing on this group's task of providing standards to ensure that Ethereum-based private permissioned networks have the same interoperability as the public mainnet.

• The **Ethereum Training Quality Working Group** has been documenting possible outcomes for different kinds of audiences and gathering data on existing training material on what is covered. This work will be important to set the basis for producing its chartered deliverables, and ensuring they meet real-world capabilities and requirements.

### Interest Group Updates

• The **Tokenization Interest Group** continues to focus on the dual pathways of showcasing the knowledge of participants through public educational webinars on important topics in the area, and on analyzing use cases for tokenization to help specific members work through some hypotheticals and deepen the general understanding of the group.

• The **DeFi Interest Groups** is developing its plans for the rest of the year. Most recently, the group has had an informative and thoughtful discussion of the recent Terra/Luna news, and its origins and expected impacts. Various perspectives from different members helped ensure the discussion was exploratory. The group is looking to continue discussing topical events as they arise and planning for discussions on themes that are important to the industry.

**As a reminder, to participate in these activities join the EEA!** Good standards are developed through collaboration between competitive implementers and their customers to ensure that we are solving real problems. 
### Welcome to Our Newest Members
